

Sir Seretse Khama Airport

There are three airport based charter companies serving the Southern Africa region. Two aircraft maintenance companies are available. There are a number of general aviation operators. Sir Seretse Khama Airport (SSKA) is the main airport serving the capital city of Botswana. It is situated on the northern side of the city, about 15 km from the city center. Access to the airport is via an exit from the Francistown road on the western by pass. Courtesy buses from hotels and lodges provide transport. Car rental companies are available in the airport for hire of vehicles. Call cabs are also available. Individuals who meet their friends and relatives provide the rest of transport. The airport is served by two scheduled airlines operating to destinations in Botswana, South Africa, and Zimbabwe. There is a cargo shuttle serving SSKA and Lanseria airport in South Africa. Some operators also own some hangars for parking of their aircraft. There is one flying club, which serves the flying enthusiasts in and around City of Gaborone. Opportunities are available for business ventures in the airport. Plots are available on lease for construction of commercial and industrial business.
